- A. Taylor Law Amendments: Pat Domaratz reported there were 2 significant changes to the Taylor Law: 1. When a new employee is hired or transitions into the bargaining union the union is to be told within 30 days. 2. Paid time to meet with union for orientation. Also, to be noted, non-members will not have representation in disciplinary matters but are welcome to join to receive such benefit.
