Please note the items below for the Labor Management meeting on Thursday:

- I. Has the proposal offered by the Provost to permit “banking “of low enrolled courses i.e., teach an overload of low enrolled courses to accumulate credit for a subsequent reduced course load, been implemented in any department successfully on campus?
- II. Are faculty, academic and professional, in the last year of a contract expected to perform differently than members in the earlier years of a contract? Are such members presumed to have a different performance program than the one received when awarded a contract?
- III. Is there an increase of work load for the College of Science and Engineering, and is this increase accompanied with a decrease in compensation?
- IV. Is the Administration prepared to establish a subcommittee of Labor Management to study salary compression within the New Paltz faculty?
