  - d. My numbers from Patrick Romain:

- i. membership numbers are holding steady: 94% FT; 62% PT;
  - ii. Professionals FT 93%/ PT 54% (4% increase in PT professionals from Dec to January but lower than summer 74%; on par with this time of year)
  - iii. Academics FT 94% / FT 65%
