#### **1. Treasurer's Report**

- a. As of September 17, 2025, we have a balance of \$4285.85 in our UUP checking account.
- b. Recent significant expenditures include:
  - i. Professional's meeting (September) (\$488.56)
  - ii. Fall mixer (\$4042.50)
  - iii. Fall membership meeting (\$608.50)
  - iv. There were recent small (under \$100 each) expenditures for Breakfast Bites outreach events.
- c. Our Good & Welfare fund remains at \$2,109.11 after collecting and donating \$300 to the Cardinal Cupboard food shelf.
